

Dear Partners,

We are pleased to share that our Ministry of Justice and Human Rights has issued a new regulation with the points regarding the update of Immigration Checking Counters, Requirements and Visiting Purpose related to the latest Free Visa Facility which take into effective on April 18, 2016.

With this new regulation, the number of Immigration Checking Points (for entrance and exit) now consists of 124 immigration counters covering 29 airports (previously only 5 airports), 88 seaports, and 7 border crossings that can be passed both to enter and leave the territory of Indonesia.

Below are the requirements and the types of visits that foreigners must meet to be entitled to get free visa facility:

1. Have a valid original passport and valid for at least 6 (six) months;
2. Have a return ticket or connecting ticket to another country;
3. Not included in the list of deterrence.

Furthermore, the types of visits that are entitled to visa-free facility are:

1. Tourism;
2. Family;
3. Social;
4. Arts and Culture;
5. The task of the government;
6. Giving lectures or seminars;
7. Attending the international exhibition;
8. attending the meeting held by the central office / representative in Indonesia;
9. Continuing trip to another country.

Please note as well that:

1. Visa-free facility is not given to the visit in the context of journalism;
2. The permit granted in a visit for a period of 30 (thirty) days from the entry date is approved, cannot be extended or converted into any other permit;
3. There are no restrictions on the number of visits in one year.
